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TAILOR ED HOMEBASED INTERVENTIONS

When you reach the top of the waiting list for this service, a project worker will contact you to begin work.

The initial part of the intervention will involve a detailed assessment of the target area, which includes asking questions, gathering data and observing the child. All interventions begin with the project worker forming a positive working relationship with your child – this can look a lot like playing.

We will design an intervention plan with your input and visit regularly to work directly with you and your child on implementing these strategies.

The frequency and duration of these visits depends upon what we think is required to make progress the target activity. Often we visit weekly, with periods of more intense support at times.

We will try to organise visits that fit with your family life and the target area we are trying to support. These can include early morning, evening or weekend visits.

A homebased intervention will end when we've achieved or progressed with the target area. After an intervention has finished, we will contact you to see if any further services are required.

For the homebased intervention the waiting time can be significant and hard to predict. Please feel free to contact us if you want to find out your position on the waiting list.

If whilst you are waiting your circumstances change, including practical things like changes of address or contact number, it would be really helpful if you could let us know.

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
